**Q. Leila Lacan was Connecticut's first-round pick a couple years ago. How familiar are you with her? Have you ever played together or against each other, and how do you see your game complementing her?**

NELL ANGLOMA: I did one year with Leila Lacan when I was in INSEP. I'm happy to meet her again. That's great.

**Q. What was your reaction like to hear your name called today? And what has it been like to be in New York for this moment?**

NELL ANGLOMA: It's been a lot for me because I work hard for this. I feel so excited and so grateful for my family, for my coach and all the people who support me. I feel happy and blessed. So blessed.

**Q. What's one thing that American audiences should know about your game?**

NELL ANGLOMA: I think I would say I'm a competitor. I play with a lot of energy and passion. I want to do my best to help my team win. Just excited to meet all of them to show them who I am.
